



Company Contract – 2010-2011

We agree to the following policies and requirements:

Attendance: Attend regular technique classes at Dance/10 PAC.

Technique Classes: All missed required classes must be made up in order to remain in the company. Excessive absences will be addressed individually. All dancers must maintain their technical level.

Rehearsal Classes: Everyone must attend the last two rehearsals prior to competition/performance. If these rehearsals are missed, the dancer will be excused from the dance for that event.

Be aware that your attendance at all of the technique and rehearsal classes during the months of March through July is critical. Please try to plan any family vacations after nationals or Disney Magic Music Days. All absences must be cleared with the Director well in advance regarding the reason for any absence or it is considered "unexcused." No more than two (2) unexcused absences per dance year. (A dance year is defined as September through July)

Summer Requirements: During July, all company members will be required to attend their required classes. It is imperative that you keep your dance training throughout the entire year. Participation in the August Dance Intensive is highly encouraged. **Please note that the recital will be on July 16th, 2011.**

Competitions: Each company member must commit to attend all competitions scheduled for the company at the beginning of the year. We dance as a team and every member of the team is vital. In an emergency, an exception can be made at the discretion of the Director. If sick or injured to an extent that the dancer is absolutely unable to dance, the company director and dance choreographer must be notified immediately. The dancer will be taken out of the dance for that competition. Everyone must attend the last two rehearsals prior to every competition. If rehearsal is missed the dancer will be taken out of the dance for that competition.

Rehearsals: Rehearsal class times will not vary. If an extra rehearsal is scheduled, we will notify you as far in advance as possible. Most of our company faculty members are professional performers and choreographers; therefore their schedules are busy and may have to schedule rehearsals when they are available.

Respect & Support: Each company member must maintain mutual respect for other team members, the director, teachers, choreographers and line captains well as maintaining good rehearsal, performance, and competition attitudes and conduct. You should help support other company members by being attentive at competitions and performances, even when not dancing. Please wear Dance/10 Logo apparel or warm-ups to show other studios our strong community of dancers and parents.

Physical Conditioning: It is the responsibility of the individual to maintain appropriate physical condition to participate in the company.

Required Rehearsal Attire:

Females: leotard and tights, jazz pants and top, shoes appropriate to routine and hair secured away from face.

Males: sweat pants or shorts, and t shirts and shoes appropriate to routine.

Outside conflicts: Religious affiliation: We are aware certain Holy Days/occasions are sacred to a person's individual faith. When one of these occasions becomes a conflict, we expect both the company and individual families to be as flexible as the situation permits. These conflicts will be addressed on an individual basis.

Dance/10 Dancers, Inc. Non-Profit (booster club) - \$25 annual membership fee

We have a wonderful non-profit fundraising unit associated with the studio. They help to bring dance based educational opportunities to our students. Participation in all fundraising events is essential as our booster clubs works hard to ensure that we can help offset the cost of fees for members, therefore we charge a minimal \$25 annual fee.

Prize Donation: Donate one (1) drawing/ raffle prize per dance year. Prize to be a value of \$25.00.

Service Requirement: All company members (or parents) must assist with company functions (i.e. set up or clean up for a show, load or unload for one show or performance, oversee the raffle or any other fundraising effort, bingo, candy sales, car wash, etc.
