

# Dress Code

For safety reasons dancers are not permitted to wear jewelry in class.

Cover-ups should be worn to and from the studio, however they must be removed upon request.



## Why does Dance/10 require a dress code?

Our dress code is designed so faculty can see the dancer's body lines, including posture, arms, legs and feet. Dancers will get the most out of their classes when they follow the dress code.



## Do students need to wear dress code?

Students are required to wear dance attire for all classes.



## How should hair be styled for class?

Hair should be pulled back, completely out of the students face. Buns are required for ballet classes.



## What shoes are needed for class?

The shoes worn in class should be appropriate to the style of class. No street shoes are allowed in the dance studio. Each class has specific requirements. Please see the following pages for additional information.

#### Hair

Dancers are required to wear tights (pink, tan or black are acceptable).

## Shoes

Shoes appropriate to style of class. See below.

## Leotard

Dancers are required to wear a leotard, crop top and shorts/leggings, or a unitard. Any color or style they like. *Clothing must be fitted to body.*

## Hair

Hair neatly and securely pulled back out of dancer's face. Ponytail is acceptable.

## Tights

Tights are not required for class, unless students are wearing boycut shorts or unitard.

### Contemporary & Lyrical

Tan slip-on jazz shoes.  
or  
half sole lyrical shoe.

### Modern

Same as lyrical or barefoot.

### Tap

Black tap oxford with rubber on sole.

## Ballet Dresses

Our younger dancers are welcome to wear a ballet dress. (Older dancers can wear a ballet skirt, if desired. Must be removed upon instructor request.)



## Hair

Hair pulled up into a neat and secure bun.

## Leotard

Dancers are required to wear a leotard. They can wear any color and neckline they would like.

## Tights

Dancers are required to wear tights (pink or tan are acceptable).

## Dance Shoes

Pink ballet shoes required.



## Dance Bag

**Jazz | Tap | Ballet | Lyrical | Modern | Acrobatics | Turns & Jumps**  
Shorts (athletic style) and a fitted tank top, fitted muscle shirt or fitted t-shirt. Shoes appropriate to style.

## Hip Hop

**Athletic wear. Nothing baggy. NO JEANS.**

Sneakers are acceptable as long as they are clean and free of debris. Black jazz shoes acceptable.

## Required Dance Shoes

### Jazz | Turns/Jumps | Lyrical

Black slip-on jazz shoes.

### Tap

Black oxford tap shoe with rubber on sole

### Modern

Same as lyrical or barefoot.

### Acrobatics

Barefoot.

### Ballet

Black ballet shoes.

### Hip Hop

Sneakers (clean free of debris) or black slip on jazz shoes.
